New Business & Key Discussion Points

1. HighSET Classes

2. Advisory Board Meeting Schedule

- The group decided to **move** future Advisory Board meetings to **Wednesdays**, **6–7pm**, on a quarterly basis (every three months).
- The next meeting is tentatively set for the last Wednesday in June.

3. Recreation (Rec) Fund

- The center has **funds** (from a previous comedy show fundraiser) that **must** be spent by July 1 or they're lost.
- The community suggested various uses:
- Group trips (Six Flags, zoo)
- Coffee machine/supplies
- Music-related items (for a potential music group/"music room")
- Talent show expenses
- "Make Your Own Pizza" Day supplies
- Final decisions will involve consulting leadership (Katie, Alicia) and possibly convening an extra session if needed.

4. Event Committees

• To better manage new events and ideas (e.g., talent show, music group, movie night), the group agreed that **smaller committees** should form for each event. This approach helps divide tasks and increase member involvement.

5. Upcoming / Proposed Activities

- Movie Night: A Marvel movie was requested by Deaf community members, so subtitles will be used.
- Comedy Show: Scheduled for June 5 (fundraiser).
- **Bocce Tournament**: May 31 in the North End (collaboration with other centers).
- Cooking Class: A local volunteer (Colleen) will come monthly to teach cooking (starting soon).
- Rave Event: Mention of a multi-center sober "rave" at the Phoenix in May (details forthcoming).
- Music Group/Room: Ongoing idea to provide instruments (guitars, drums, etc.) but depends on renovations and space.

6. Community Meeting Process

- Held on Wednesdays at 12:30pm.
- Any center-wide decisions (like approving an event) go for a **community vote** at these meetings.
